GRANT FUNDING AVAILABLE FOR LOCAL SPORTS CLUBS

Local sports clubs can benefit from generous grants of up to £50,000 to improve grassroots football facilities in their communities.

The **Football Foundation's** grant scheme covers 75% of the cost for essential maintenance machinery, helping clubs significantly enhance their pitch quality. Typical machinery packages include vital tools like a 4WD Compact Tractor, Rotary Mower Deck, and a Pitch Groomer or Aerator.

Access to the grant is via the **Pitch Power** app to assess the condition of the pitches, which then generates a pitch report that forms the basis of the grant application.

The **Grounds Management Association (GMA)** pitch assessment team is available to support clubs through this process. They review the Pitch Power reports and provide expert advice on the best maintenance practices and specific equipment required.

MEGA-MIX INCREASES EFFICIENCY AT JCB



Since opening in 2018, JCB Golf and Country Club has rapidly established itself as a forward-thinking, premier facility, blending modern course design with innovative maintenance practices. In 2023, Course Manager Callum Wark took delivery of a new Mega-Mix, which Spray Technician Dan Waring has been putting to excellent use ever since.

Dan, who won the Amenity Sprayer Operator of the Year Award in 2024, said: "We got the Mega-Mix at the start of the year. Our main purpose for it was to improve our mixing because we use a lot of granulars for our foliar feed on fairways. We've found that using our current method of mixing, we get a lot of separation and granular settlement at the bottom of the tank, which obviously causes nozzle blockages, so we've decided to use this.

"It's improved a lot of our efficiency. It normally takes about an hour to go from spraying the tank out, to actually refilling to get back out again, which for a busy golf and country club, it's not practical. It's not feasible for us, but the Mega-Mix is saving us a lot of time. It's probably saving about half an hour per tank, which when you consider fairways for us is 12 tanks, so it's going to save us a lot of time on that.

"And another thing is it's a lot quicker to fill up. We can be in and out within about five minutes from coming back to the shed. So it's a lot handier on busy golf days. Also, one of the upsides to us is because it mixes so well, we've increased our granular inputs. Normally we're averaging about

two bags per tank on the mix, depending on what the Course Manager wants, but now we've actually increased that nearly by two, to double.



So that shows how good this is at mixing, and we've not even had to mix at full revs on the engine to get the agitation that we need to get it mixed properly. So, it's a great machine, and I can't wait to use it more to help us develop further on the course."

With the Mega-Mix fully integrated into the team's workflow, JCB Golf and Country Club continues

BRITAIN'S FIRST RYDER CUP VENUE, AND THE SWEEP-N-FILL



Moortown Golf Club in Leeds holds the unique distinction of hosting the second Ryder Cup — and the first to be played in Britain — back in 1929.

Designed by Alister MacKenzie in 1908, this heathland/woodland-moorland layout represents one of his earliest and most influential works. It showcases the deep bunkering, strategic design, and undulating greens typical of the architect's style, rewarding thoughtful approach play and strong short-game control.

Today, Moortown remains one of Yorkshire's premier courses. Under the stewardship of Course Manager Steve Robinson, supported by Deputy Course Manager Kevin Fox and the greenkeeping team, the club continues to thrive



— with significant efforts underway to restore and preserve many of MacKenzie's original design features.

Steve had purchased one of the early Mk3 Sweep-N-Fill brushes when they were first introduced to the UK, so when GreenTek took over distribution in 2025, he was an obvious choice to approach for long-term feedback on the product. We met up with him in August during his end-of-summer renovations, and he explained his programme:

"My main role this week is to hollow core our greens to try and dilute the thatch, and then we're



going with a really heavy dressing, putting down around two tonnes per green, and then using the Sweep-N-Fill to brush that sand quantity in. The Sweep-N-Fill was purchase probably 15 years ago, and it's made such a big difference in being able to get that quantity of sand down the holes, whilst being kind to the turf.

"You don't feel like you are being over aggressive, and just letting gravity get the sand down the holes. Because it's got that ability to get it down

the holes, it's not hampering us going forward with so much on the surface, which is the greenkeepers worst nightmare when you're trying to do mowing. The Sweep-N-Fill gets most of it down the holes, and the mowers can crack on and do what they're designed to do.

"The best thing is it does exactly what you hope it will. We've got pretty nice conditions at the moment. It's fairly dry, so you can really push the limits of how much sand you can put down on a green, and this is realistically the only way you can do it."

We are grateful to Steve and his team for their long-term experience and feedback on the Sweep-N-Fill. This was a key factor in our

decision to take up the opportunity to become the new importer of this product, a decision which has since been solidly confirmed by the uptake from GreenTek Key Dealers and end users alike.

The bristles themselves are thicker, longer, and less densely packed so that they pass between the blades of grass, rather than smearing over the surface. The brushes run on castor wheels, with the bristle tips set just lightly skimming the turf. This causes the bristles to flex slightly backwards, then energetically flick forwards repeatedly as the brush moves over the turf, shattering the wormcasts and dispersing them without smearing.

FLICKER-BRUSH SOLVES WORMCAST PROBLEM AT WETHERBY GOLF CLUB



Darren Morris, Course Manager at Wetherby Golf Club, explains why they were ideally placed to trial the new 5.3m Flicker-Brush throughout its development.

"We had two main reasons for utilising the new fairway brush that GreenTek have developed. One has been to improve sward density on our fairways, and the other has been to disperse worm casts, which, as we know, are becoming more and more of a problem for every golf course in the UK."

"We have been having issues over the last three years because we have reverted back to mowing our fairways 50:50. This is causing us quite a few issues with the members. At present they are complaining about washboarding or ribbing on the fairways. Utilizing the new brush from GreenTek, this has dramatically improved the sward density and the cut quality of our fairways. So much so, that we now brush before we cut, and we are getting a 50% more yield per cut than

we were doing before." Darren explained that this had enabled him to reduce fairway mowing from three to two cuts per week.

He continued, "The biggest problem we have is when we get into the autumn season we start to struggle with worms. At Wetherby Golf Club, since 2015 we have had eight consecutive floods. This has pushed the nutrient content in our sward through the roof. So worm activity for us is absolutely diabolical in winter, so much so that we do actually stop cutting our fairways in November. The reason that we do this is to try and stop the damage to our cutting units, and obviously it reduces the amount of time we have to spend back-lapping or resharpening cylinders.

"The results so far have been very, very encouraging, especially worm cast dispersal"



DISPERSING CASTS WITHOUT KILLING WORMS IS A WIN-WIN FOR DURHAM COUNTY CRICKET CLUB



Having read about the new 5.3m Flicker-Brush, and its ability to shatter worm casts without smearing, Vic Demain, Head of Grounds at Durham County Cricket Club, approached us and asked if we could produce a smaller version specifically for cricket outfields. A prototype 2.2m version was duly manufactured, which Vic immediately tested, and here gives us his verdict on.

"One of the biggest problems that all groundsman have now due to the eradication of chemicals is worm activity, and it's getting worse and worse, particularly with these wetter winters we've had. One thing that I've been looking at is using the GreenTek Flicker-Brush, which has actually been great for us, because every other sort of brush that we've used just smears them. Whereas the Flicker-Brush, because of the way it's designed, it tends to break the worm cast up."

"But not only that, if we're cutting our outfield they dull our mowers off in no time, and it's costing us a fortune in sharpening the machines. So the Flicker-Brush, breaking up the worm cast actually disperses them, and means that we're actually cutting grass rather than cutting soil."

There are, of course, various products on the market which are supposedly able to control worms. I'm talking mainly of soil conditioners.

"I actually still want the worms in the ground. They do a lot of good for the earth"



You can't put down sprays now to eradicate worms, which is, in my opinion, a good thing because I actually still want the worms in the ground. They do a lot of good for the earth, in that they give natural aeration and they eat up some of the thatch. So I actually want them, I don't want to kill the worms. What we're finding with the Flicker-Brush is, yes, we will always have the worm casts, but the Flicker-Brush enables us to break those casts up, to carry on mowing, and to present the ground in the best possible condition.

"So for us it's a great tool, but I think not only at this level of cricket, I think even in a village club, if people were able to access one of those, it would save a heck of a lot of time and help them all."







SUMMER OVERSEEDING AT SCARCROFT GOLF CLUB



Scarcroft Golf Club is a highly regarded 18-hole parkland course located on the outskirts of Leeds. It resides in an area noted for some of Yorkshire's finest golf courses, along with neighbouring Alwoodley, Moor Allerton, Moortown, and Sand Moor, to name but a few.

new seed coming through, which is obviously very pleasing. We've been overseeding now for, I think this is our eighth year, two to three times a year at about 5g/m².

“When overseeding is required we don't have to worry about upcoming competitions as there is very little surface disruption to the playing surface. We then chose to run the greensmower over it after the application of the seed, with no boxers on, just to lightly roll the surface. And as

you can see, it's left the greens perfectly playable in a fantastic condition.

CAN MICRO-CORING THROUGH WINTER AVOID THE NEED FOR A FULL SPRING RENOVATION?

Bruce Jamieson brings decades of green-keeping expertise to this investigation. Formerly Course Manager at Royal Porthcawl and later Director of Agronomy for the PGA European Tour from 1988 to 1995, he has spent the past 30 years working as an independent golf course consultant.

Drawing on this extensive experience, he was commissioned by GreenTek at the end of 2022 to assess whether monthly micro-coring with the Dyna-Corers could effectively reduce organic matter levels during the winter months, and potentially lessen the need for disruptive spring renovations.



Matt Rolls, course manager

Hartley Wintney Golf Club was selected for the trial, where Bruce collaborated closely with Course Manager Matt Rolls. Together, they

monitored the performance of the Dyna-Corers across three types of greens—an older push-up green (now rebuilt) and two of the modern sand based greens—evaluating both agronomic impacts and playability. Here, Bruce and Matt share their observations from the trial:

Bruce: "We had three different types of greens. To start with, we took tests from three greens, one push up, one 1999 green, and one 2015 green, and had the tests analysed by ETL in Scotland for organic material. Having got those results, we then started a program of every month through the winter of '22 to '23, taking out cores with the Dyna-Corers, and at the end of that period of six

operations we tested the greens again and found that the results we had achieved were what we had hoped to achieve on the sand based screens." An average of 17% reduction in organic material was recorded on the sand based greens.

Matt: "The use of the Dyna-Corers allowed us to aerate through the winter time, and what we did find was, especially after a number of applications, is that the surfaces became firmer. And going through all winter, even on the old green, we still found by the end of the winter that the green was a lot firmer than we were expecting. It worked well. We didn't bother doing a spring renovation. We waited to see how it was, and then looked at the results from there on. So after the last of the spring operations we discussed it at Greens committee, and then we decided that it was such a successful operation that we purchased the Dyna-Corer units, and we've been using them through the winter times ever since."

Bruce: "What we've also found as a club, that having done that, the spring renovation is minimal. We can go in with solid tines in the spring, with top dressing, and overseeding, and the members get the greens in better condition, come Easter time, than they would have done if we were doing a large hollow core operation going into that period. Because weather can be a bit unpredictable at that time of year."

Matt: "And also, even through the winter time, we were able to do the operation, clear away the debris, and then roll each green as we finished. And the members felt no disturbance or disruption for their playing through the winter time."

Conclusion

The winter micro-coring programme at Hartley Wintney GC demonstrates that consistent, low-disruption aeration can significantly reduce organic matter, improve firmness, and maintain member satisfaction—all while avoiding the need for a major spring renovation. By spreading maintenance throughout the quieter winter months, the club not only preserved surface quality but also ensured better-playing conditions earlier in the following season. This trial suggests that, for many courses, adopting a structured winter micro-coring regime could offer a more efficient and golfer-friendly approach to managing organic matter, and preparing greens for the competitive spring period.





PREPARING ROYAL BIRKDALE FOR THE OPEN



When we caught up with Sean McLean, Course Manager at Royal Birkdale Golf Club, it was early October 2025. This was their maintenance week, and the course was partially closed to allow for an intensive renovation program across the championship links.

Having taken over the role only three years ago, Sean is facing the task of preparing one of golf's most iconic venues for the 154th Open Championship, only nine months away. Yet, he's quick to stress that the work being carried out goes far beyond Open preparations. "We're doing

a lot of procedures ahead of the Open next year," he explains, "but it's also for general play. It's not just targeted at the Open. It'll be something that we'll be looking to do annually going forward."

Sean outlines the scope of this autumn's renovation programme:

"Starting off with verticutting and brushing, using the GreenTek units. And then following on from

that, this week it's been scarifying to target the top 7mm in the profile".

Using a plug cutter, he inspects a core from the green and decides to take the Thatch-Away Scarifier Cassettes another millimetre deeper. Four clicks of the Set-by-Feel adjusters later, and the greensmower is back in action — a small adjustment, but one that makes all the difference.

The renovation continues with further processes to reduce organic matter, including deep-tine aeration with solid tines, followed by micro-coring with Dyna-Corer units. Next comes seeding with a fine fescue mix, applied using their Dyna-Seeder units.

This is followed by a once over with a pedestrian solid tine aerator set at a shallow depth to punch even more potholes for the seed. "Following on from that it's been a heavy topdress, and then work all the material into the surface and help

dilute that top profile. So, yeah" he concludes, "all these products have been good, and all these inputs have been a great help for carrying that out".
